## Volunteer driver (RSPCA vehicle provided)

### Aims

To transport animals to and from the local vets, boarding establishments or other RSPCA sites as required and as directed by the branch/centre. Support our Charity Shops with collecting and delivering donated goods as and when required.

### Tasks and responsibilities

- To transport animals to and from the local vets as required.
- To collect donated goods such as pet food for our Animal Centre, donated goods for our Charity Shops as and when required.
- To handle animals that are to be transported, as set down by the branch's/centre's guidelines and within health and safety guidelines. This will involve lifting animals of various sizes and weight.
- To comply with the branch's rules and regulations, carry out some administrative work and undertake appropriate training.
- To use RSPCA equipment to transport the animals such as leads, cages, vari kennels etc.

### Additional notes

A driving license check, online assessment and driving assessment will be required to meet our insurer's requirements. Please speak to your volunteer coordinator for more information.

Training will be provided.

RSPCA Gwent Branch serves Gwent & Brecknock. Covering Newport, Monmouthshire, Torfaen, Blaina Gwent, Brecon, Builth Wells, Hay on Wye.

Volunteers will be able to claim out-of-pocket expenses such as travel costs, these will be agreed with your Volunteer Coordinator in advance.

Drivers must be able to lift animals into and out of the vehicle safely.
